## COMMUNIQUE 30 July 2012

### HEALTH MINISTERS ANNOUNCE NEW APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO TEN NATIONAL BOARDS FOR THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION SCHEME

The Australian Health Workforce Ministerial Council (the Ministerial Council) is very pleased to announce new appointments and reappointments of Chairs, practitioner and community members to fill vacancies arising across ten National Boards for the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme (NRAS). The vacancies arise primarily as a result of the expiry of 105 terms of the inaugural appointments to these national boards (as made by the Ministerial Council in 2009).

The details of the statutory appointments are set out in the **attachment** to this Communiqué.

There was a strong response to the national press advertisement for candidates issued on 11 February 2012.

A total of 274 individuals applied for appointment/reappointment to 105 vacancies across the 10 National Boards as follows:-

- 134 health practitioners applied for appointment or reappointment as a practitioner member and/or chair of the relevant board (for 72 vacancies);
- 140 persons applied for community member appointment (for 33 vacancies).

Around 90% of inaugural national board members sought reappointment. Ministers thanked these inaugural members (including Chairs) for expressing their continued interest in, and commitment to, the work of the national boards in regulating the ten professions under the national scheme. Ministers also acknowledged the significant efforts of all inaugural members during their first term of appointment, in preparing for, and then implementing, national regulation under NRAS.

Consistent with previous appointment rounds, Ministers considered the significant response from persons seeking appointment as community members reflects the considerable interest from the community in the work of the national boards, and the importance of the contributions that community members make to the national boards and the NRAS.

The triennial appointment process provides an opportunity for renewal across the membership of the national boards, including Chairs, where there are eligible candidates with suitable skills, experience, qualities and abilities appropriate for appointment. Renewal provides for new members to be introduced, to strike a balance between retaining expertise from experienced board members and the perspectives and experience that new members bring to the ongoing functions of the boards.

Ministers welcomed returning board members and Chairs and all new practitioner and community member appointees and wished them well over the coming years with their important regulatory roles for the benefit of the Australian public.

In particular, Ministers welcomed the Chairs of the Physiotherapy Board of Australia and Podiatry Board of Australia to their new roles, noting the experience they have gained serving on the respective national boards as practitioner members during their inaugural terms.

In making these appointments, Ministers also wished to acknowledge and thank the inaugural, outgoing national board Chairs for their dedication and contributions over the last three years. Ministers also thanked all outgoing inaugural practitioner and community members for their dedicated service on the national boards and wished them well for the future.

The appointments and reappointments will commence for a period of one to three years from 30 August 2012, and are made under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act*, as in force in each state and territory.

The appointments and reappointments are announced today to assist with the smooth transition from the inaugural appointed national boards to the newly constituted national boards from August 2012.
